

## ATTORNEY TIERS

Tier	Description
1	<ul> <li>ROOKIE</li> <li>New to the personal injury practice, or new attorney.</li> <li>Requires lots of coaching and supervision on all aspects of handling a claim.</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>ATTORNEY</li> <li>Comfortable handling the pre-litigation aspect of a personal injury claim on claims worth less than \$50,000.</li> <li>Beginning to learn the litigation process and get experience.</li> </ul>
3	<ul> <li>LITIGATION ATTORNEY</li> <li>Experienced litigator who is skilled in taking depositions, motion hearings, and is beginning to get experience in trials.</li> <li>Skilled at handling files up to the \$250,000 range. Still requires supervision and coaching on files larger than that.</li> </ul>
4	<ul> <li>TRIAL ATTORNEY</li> <li>This attorney, as a first chair, has won multiple jury trials.</li> <li>Attorney is skilled in all aspects of litigation.</li> <li>Attorney is capable of handling files up to \$1M as lead litigator and trial attorney.</li> <li>Has been first chair in 3 or more jury trials.</li> </ul>
5	<ul> <li>SENIOR TRIAL ATTORNEY</li> <li>This attorney has obtained several jury verdicts above \$1M as first chair.</li> <li>Attorney is capable of handling a file of any size and complexity.</li> </ul>
